Collection artist Todd Fuller will conduct his residency from 30 September – 28 October 2016.

Todd will be working in the studio over the course of a month on two projects: a hand-drawn film titled 'The Tinkerer' and a project touching on social challenges in regional Australia titled 'Gay in Grafton.'
